1945 Andrew purchased 51 acres of land from Leo Yena north of and adjacent to the Kempf Farm.

1950 Andrew sold about 20 acres of field land during the extreme drought of the 50's to the Van De Walle Farms. This land was at the southeast boundary of the Kempf Farm.

1966 Mark and Roselyn Keller Kempf built a home near the Kempf homestead house. They have four children, Andrea, Benjamin, Craig and Derek.
